TAKE NOTICE that I Edwin Smith of St. Mary's Catholic School, Blood Indian Reservation in the Province of Alberta, Disciplinarian, being a person aggrieved by a certain conviction or order hereinafter more particularly mentioned, do hereby give notice of my intention to appeal from a certain conviction or order made on the 25th day of February A.D. 1928 by you the above named J. W. Low, Police Magistrate in and for the Province of Alberta at Cardston in said Province whereby you the said J. W. Low did convict me the undersigned Edwin Smith for that on the 9th day of January A.D. 1928 at the Blood Indian Reserve in the said Province of Alberta did unlawfully assault Albert Many Fingers, contrary to Section 291 of the Criminal Code of Canada, and all amendments thereto, and for my said offence did order me to pay Ten (10) Dollars and Costs amounting to Nine and 20/100 (9.20) Dollars or in default thereof to serve ten days in the Provincial

Goal at Lethbridge in the Province of Alberta.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that I intend to enter and prosecute my said appeal to the District Court of the Judicial District of Macleod at the sittings thereof to be holden at the Town of Macleod in the Province of Alberta (being the judicial centre of the district where the cause of information or complaint arose) on the 3rd day of April A.D. 1928.
