
UPON AN APPLICATION made this day to the Court by the Plaintiff and upon hearing counsel and it appearing that upon the 12th day of March, 1919, it was adjudged and decreed that the marriage had and solemnized on the 22nd day of December, 1906, at Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta, between the Plaintiff and the Defendant be dissolved by reason that since the celebration thereof the said Defendant has been guilty of adultery, Unless sufficient cause be shown to the Court why this decree should not be made absolute within three months from the entry thereof and no such cause having been shown.

be and the same is hereby absolutely dissolved.
