UPOS AN APPLICATION made this day to the Goart by the Plaintiff and upon hearing counsel and it appearing that upon the 18th day of March, 1919, it was adjudged and decreed that the marriage had and colemnized on the tind day of December, 1908, at Maconton, in the Province of Alberta, between the Plaintiff and the Defendant be dissolved by reason that since the calcebration thereof the said Defendant has been guilty of afultry.
