PETITION FOR DIVORCE

TO THIS HONOURABLE COURT:

I hereby petition for a decree of divorce from the Respondent on the grounds and in the circumstances following:

1. Grounds

A. My Petition is under The Divorce Act (Canada), Section 3 (d) and 4 (e)(i).

B. The particulars of my grounds for divorce are:

(i) The Respondent deserted me on or about the 2nd day of July, A.D. 1932 and we have lived separate and apart each from the other since our separation.

(ii) The Respondent both prior and subsequent to our separation has been improperly associating with other men and has treated me with such disrespect and mental cruelty as to render intolerable the resumption and continuation of cohabitation as man and wife.

2. Reconciliation

A. The particulars of the circumstances which may assist the Court in ascertaining whether there is a possibility of reconciliation or resumption of

(i) The Petitioner has attempted reconciliation on several occasions in the past but the Respondent has refused to consider the same.

B. The following efforts to reconcile have been made:

(i) 1932 and 1933 efforts by Solicitors for the Parties.

(ii) 1956 personal attempt by Petitioner.

3. Particulars of Marriage

A. The date of the marriage was: The 27th day of November, A.D. 1919.

B. The place of the marriage was: Lethbridge, Alberta.

D. My domicile is: Alberta.

E. Such domicile has subsisted since: our marriage.

F. My place of birth was: Dingle, Idaho.

G. I have been ordinarily resident in Alberta since our marriage and have

actually resided in the said Province near the Hamlet of Wrentham and near the City of Lethbridge, both in the Province of Alberta, continuously, except for short absences for vacations, since our marriage.

5. Age and Disability

Neither of the Parties are under any disability, either by reason of age or any other legal disability.

6. Children

A. The names and dates of birth of all living children of the marriage as defined by The Divorce Act (Canada) are:

DENNIS ALVIN NATE, born 4th February, 1924.

FAY MARIE NATE (now KUZMAR) born 15th December, 1920.

Both children are over the age of twenty-one years and able to earn their own livelihood.

7. Other Proceedings

A. No other petitions or proceedings have been instituted with reference to the marriage or any child thereof, nor have there been any Actions for alimony or Applications under any statute.

8. Separation Agreements and Financial Arrangements

A. There are no written or oral separation or financial agreements between the Parties.

B. Both Parties have independent financial resources, both income and capital.

9. Collusion, Condonation and Connivance

A. There has been no collusion in relation to this Petition.

B. There has been no condonation of or connivance at the grounds for divorce
