THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me, EMILY MURPHY of the City of Edmonton, Province of Alberta, hereby revoking all Wills, Testaments or Codicils by me heretofore made.

I devise and bequeath all my estate, real and personal, to my executors and trustees hereinafter named in trust for the purposes following:--

Firstly, to pay my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses, and thereafter in trust to dispose of and pay over or convey the same to the person or persons or corporations herein named as follows:-

Secondly, to pay the sum of \$600.00 (six hundred dollars), in the purchase and erection of a monument to mark my place of burial.

Thirdly, I give and bequeath unto Arthur Murphy, my husband, the sum of \$1000. (one thousand dollars) free from succession or any other duties.

Fourthly, I direct my executors to set aside or appropriate the sum of \$10,000. (ten thousand dollars) free from succession or any other duties for the use of my husband, Arthur Murphy, during his life, the sum of \$10,000. (ten thousand dollars) to be invested in Dominion Government bonds, the dividend or interest of which shall be payable in equal portions either quarterly or half-yearly in the discretion of my executors, and I direct that the said sum of \$10,000. (ten thousand dollars) on the death of the said Arthur Murphy, shall fall into the residue of my estate.

Fifthly, I devise and bequeath to my grand-daughter, Emily Doris Cleave Kenwood, the sum of \$1,000. (one thousand dollars).
