

## PUBLIC ADMINISTRATOR'S AFFIDAVIT.

I, Thomas William Swanborough, of the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta,

Esquire, make oath and say:—

- Supt. of the Estates Dept.,  
(1) I am the ~~Manager~~ for the Province of Alberta, of The Trusts and Guarantee Company, Limited, the  
duly appointed Public Administrator for the Judicial District of Macleod,  
(2) On or about the 19th day of June, A.D., 1914,  
as I am informed and believe Alexander Petrie, of Village
