

WILL

Here is a brief summary of my latest Will which is in type and dated from Scapa on April 23rd, 1945. It is not a Verbatim copy but was a check on the ink one. All debts to me by anyone are cancelled. My house on Joe Camp's farm with its' furnishings I leave to Joe Camp. Bonds all to be sold both Canadian and English and with the money in the Post Office, after all debts are paid, to be divided into thirty parts: The following people to receive the number of parts stated below:

WILL.

Dated Scapa, Alta., April 23rd, 1945.

This is the last will and testament of me, Bernard Sillar Wimbush, and I hereby revoke all former testamentary dispositions made by me. I am, at this date, of sound mind and in fair health.

I appoint two executors, viz. Mr. Joe Camp, of Scapa, Alta, and Mr. Sydney C. Vallance, Solicitor, of 328A 8th Ave. W., Calgary, Phone of latter M3130.

All debts owing me at my death, by whomsoever, shall be cancelled.

I give and bequeath my house and its furnishings to Joe Camp, on whose farm it is situated, for his use absolutely. in addition to moneys hereinafter specified.

All my bonds shall be sold, both English and Canadian shall be sold, and after all just debts have been paid, (there are none at this date) and the money to my credit in the Postoffice Savings Bank at Hanna, Alta. This money shall be divided into thirty equal parts or shares, and allotted to the following eleven persons designated below. If one person among these shall die, his share will be added to the common pool of money, and shall not go to that person's heirs.

Clifford R. Wimbush, 14 Dunbar Road, Clairmont, Perth Western Australia, four shares. (4).

Mrs. Cecil Keane, 49 York Ave., Westmount, Montreal, Quebec, four shares.(4)

Arthur Camp, now in the Army, two shares. (2).

Mrs. A. Mona Fandrick, Castor, Alta, two shares. (2).

Mrs. E. Pauline Paxman, Hanna, Alta., two shares. (2).

Postmaster and Mrs. J. B. Mackenzie, Scapa, Alta., one share each. (each

(I have written this Will myself, and therefore there is no need to have it read to me. I will sign it in the presence of two witnesses in the presence of each other, and they will witness the destruction of my former will.
