All my bonds shall be sold, both Enghish and Canadian shall be sold, and after all just debts have been paid, (there are none at this date) and the money to my credit in the Postoffice Savings Bank at Hanna, Alta. This money shall be divided into thirty equal parts or shares, and allotted to the following eleven pwesons designated below. If one person among these shall die, his share will be added to the common pool of money, and shall not go th that person's heirs.
